Property in wildlife

12 (2) A person does not acquire a right of property in any wildlife except in accordance with a permit or licence issued under this Act or the Animal Health Act or as provided in subsection (3) of this section.

22 (3) A person who lawfully kills wildlife and complies with all applicable provisions of this Act and the regulations acquires the right of property in that wildlife.
